The International Contact Point is a service centre for international students and academics, providing help to ensure you're able to enjoy all the benefits of your international experience.


The ICP will help you with:



Visa/long-term residence permit extension

If you want to extend the validity of your current visa/long-term residence permit, it is necessary to submit the following documents to OAMP, before your current visa expires:

- Application form
- Passport
- Confirmation of studies in Czech language (Study Office)
- Confirmation of accommodation in Czech language (Accommodation Office at the dormitories)
- Proof of funds in Czech language (bank account statement)
- Complex healthcare insurance in Czech language
- Stamp ("kolek") for 2 500 CZK (Post Office)
- 1 photo

Insurance

Students from EU and other selected countries

We advise all students from EU, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Cuba, Japan, Macedonia, Montenegro, Turkey, Republic of Tunisia and Serbia to register at a Czech insurance company after their arrival in the Czech Republic. The registration is free of charge and it is required by Czech hospitals and doctors.

If you don't register with a Czech insurance company, you will have to pay every time you want to see a doctor or go to hospital here. Then, you will have to bring the bills to your insurance company in your home country and get it reimbursed. However, if you don't want to deal with that and don't want to pay every time you see a doctor here, we recommend to do the registration.

Non-EU students

All non-EU students (except nationals from countries mentioned in the first paragraph) who enter the Czech Republic and who will stay here for more than 90 days must arrange medical insurance in the scope of comprehensive healthcare within 90 days from entry to the territory of the Czech Republic. This medical insurance in the scope of comprehensive healthcare must be arranged exclusively with Pojišťovna VZP, a. s.

Transport in Ostrava

Public Transport

You can use buses, trolley buses or trams.

It's easy to pay for public transport in Ostrava – just use your contactless bank card in the vehicles. Simply enter the vehicle, tap your card on the yellow payment terminal next to the door, wait until it beeps, and that's it. Don't forget to tap your card (wait for the beep) every time you enter a vehicle.

If you prefer not to use your bank card, that's no problem – just go to one of our turquoise ticket machines, where you can buy a credit ticket. It's a prepaid card that you can use to tap and ride – just like you would use a bank card.

The third option is to download the "MojeDPO" phone app, and buy online tickets using the app.

Another option is to ask for an ISIC card with the ODISka application on it at the Card Centre at VSB-TUO.

Bike Sharing

You can also use bike sharing as a way to go around the city. Simply sign up once and rent bikes via the Nextbike app. Furthermore, if you use your university email, you will obtain 200 CZK as a bonus credit that will surely come in handy. Also, you have 30 minutes for free if you return the bike to one of the stations in the university campus.

In return, the women give the men decorated eggs, plum brandy, candy and ribbons for the whips. All of this to guarantee women healthy year and to preserve their youth and beauty.

Christmas

December 24 is the most enjoyable day of the Czech Christmas holidays. The Christmas tree is decorated with traditional ornaments and preparations are made for most festive dinner of the year. Christmas Eve is associated with many superstitions that usually relate to life, love, and the destiny that awaits in the year to come. According to one Czech custom, one is supposed to fast all day to see the "golden piglet" in the evening.
