INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS ARRIVING AFTER 15th MARCH 2021

Dear Students,

New restrictions for entering the Czech Republic have been introduced from 5th February 2021. **Please read and follow the instructions carefully:**

Green countries

- Australia, Iceland, Singapore, South Korea, Thailand, New Zealand, Vatican
- no restrictions

Orange countries

- Denmark, Portugal, Norway, Balearic Islands
- necessary to fill in the Passenger Locator Form before arrival
- a negative antigen or PCR test before the departure from your home country (max. 72h before departure from your home country)
- necessary to wear a respirator FFP2 or a medical face mask outside your room for 10 days after your arrival in the Czech Republic

Red countries

- Andorra, Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Lichtenstein, Luxembourg, Monaco, Netherlands, Poland, Romania, Spain, Switzerland
- necessary to fill in the <u>Passenger Locator Form</u> before arrival
- a negative antigen or PCR test before the departure from your home country (max. 72h before departure from your home country)
- another PCR test within 5 days of your arrival in the Czech Republic
- self-isolation until you present a negative result from the above-mentioned PCR test
- necessary to wear a respirator FFP2 or a medical face mask outside your room for 10 days after your arrival in the Czech Republic

Dark red countries

- all the countries not mentioned above
- necessary to fill in the <u>Passenger Locator Form</u> before arrival
- a negative PCR test before the departure from your home country (max. 72h before departure from your home country)
- another PCR test after 5 days of your arrival in the Czech Republic
- self-isolation until you present a negative result from the above-mentioned PCR test
- necessary to wear a respirator FFP2 or a medical face mask outside your room for 10 days after your arrival in the Czech Republic

Information for students from red and dark red countries:

- once you arrive at the dormitories, please register at the main reception desk in building AB, which is open 24/7
- you will get the keys to a temporarily assigned room building D, 5th floor
- you must undertake a test for COVID-19 in the Czech Republic (red countries within 5 days, dark red countries – after 5 days), Accommodation services have to inform the Regional hygiene station about your result.
- you can undertake the test at <u>Fakultní nemocnice Ostrava-Poruba</u> (hospital near campus), you can register a time slot <u>HERE</u>
 - testing centre is open from 7 am to 3 pm
 - the test costs 1 510 CZK, you must pay by card
 - if you need any assistance, please contact the <u>International Contact Point Office</u>, e-mail: barbora.stivarova@vsb.cz
 - please keep the receipt of the payment for reimbursement
- once you get the test results, you have to bring it to the Accommodation Office, where it will be reimbursed. Then you can move to your assigned room.
- until you know your test results, you will be self-isolated. You can leave your accommodation to travel
 to purchase food and basic necessities and medications, travel to a doctor, attend urgent official
 matters, or to a post office. The limitation of free movement of persons mainly covers:
 - ✓ restrict your presence in publicly accessible places to the minimum time required
 - ✓ when in contact with others, please maintain a safe distance of at least two meters
 - ✓ do not attend any public events, do not visit restaurants, gyms or fitness centres, etc.
 - √ do not accept visitors in your room
 - ✓ use a face mask to cover your mouth and nose every time you leave the room
- if you have a positive test result, please inform the staff of the Accommodation Office immediately

- please be aware of the fact that the receptionists will be checking compliance with the rules
