- This group work is analysed, discussed and reflected on in online meetings and on the high seas in the western Baltic region on board a traditional sailing ship.

Sailing into Science is open to all students who have a good working knowledge of English, and who are able to swim confidently in deep and open water for at least 15 uninterrupted minutes.
