KLIP (Korean Language Intensive Program):</b> If you are interested in studying Korean language during the term break between the 2 semesters (offered to the students who are studying for 2 semesters at KU Sejong), we are glad to offer a discount for our KLIP program (Application fees: waived / Tuition fee: 20% discount for 1 term). Please ask exchange program coordinator for more information.	
<b>Important Notice Regarding Courses</b> Korea University Sejong Campus has student limitation quota at each department/classes, so we cannot guarantee students will be able to take ALL the courses they wish to take. Therefore, if the students have any essential courses they need to take for graduation, we suggest them to take it at your home university. It is strongly recommended for students to make their backup plan before they apply.
