Duration of Exchange	One semester or one academic year  **For students of Mainland China, Hong Kong, Macau nationality, we only accept 1-semester exchange due to visa issue. Students with Mainland China nationality can only apply for single entry visa.  **NCCU accepts Japanese/ Korean students to go for one year exchange starting from spring semester to follow the Japanese/ Korean semester term, though there is still some time difference, for example the Japanese/ Korean Spring semester starts from April 1st while Taiwan one starts from February 1st.		
Required Level of Language Proficiency	Intensive Mandarin language courses are open to students of all levels, including absolute beginners.  **Chinese Language Proficiency:  Students who want to take academic classes taught in Chinese are advised to have Chinese proficiency at least equivalent to TOCFL Superior / HSK Level 4.  **English Language Proficiency:  Students who wish to take academic classes taught in English are advised to have English proficiency at least equivalent to TOEFL iBT 79-80 / IELTS 6.0 / TOEIC 700/ CEFR B2.

The fee varies in different countries.</li> <li>Apply to 1-year exchange students with ARC (Alien Resident Certificate):     </li> <li>Buy Overseas Medical Insurance in home country before departure for at least the first 6 months in Taiwan (SepFeb. or FebJuly).
