

Guidelines to ensure the safety and health and fire protection for the persons staying in the dorms VSB-TUO

- 1) The resident has the right** to ensure the safety and protection of health, during their stay on the tracks.
- 2) The resident is obliged to:**
 - a) ensure as far as possible for his own safety and the safety of all other persons, which directly affects his actions
 - b) ensure that your actions do not hinder the proper behavior and the conditions for their accommodation and accommodation of other persons
 - c) act so that its behaviour was not the cause of the fire or other emergencies
 - d) in the event of fire, or other emergencies, is required to provide adequate personal assistance, they do not endangered themselves, person nearby, or unless his important circumstance
 - e) participate in creating a secure and healthy environment, and in particular the application of established and adopted measures (follow the information signs, instructions given in local traffic regulations (e.g. operating systems, fire systems, alarm of the directive) and guidelines instructions of the employee of Accommodation service ("AS") instructions, etc.
 - f) to compensate for damage (AS) caused intentionally or negligently
 - g) notify the worker AS an injury, which he suffered in the accommodation, if his health allows, and also an injury of another student, of which he was a witness (if student's health condition does not allow his injury he himself)
- 3) It is forbidden to:**
 - a) smoking in all areas that are not marked as: "Areas reserved for smoking"
 - b) be present at the premises of the dorm, under the influence of alcohol or other substance abuse
 - c) have input into the track area, substances and articles for which it can be assumed that may endanger the safety of persons
 - d) without the knowledge of authorised staff, bring animals into dorm
 - e) yield out of the space of the Dorm, any movable property without the knowledge of the employee
 - f) handle (handle, turn on, turn off) with a device, that was not over in the accommodation allocated to, and was not advised with its operation
 - g) interfere with the design of the equipment (machines, equipment, installations, technical equipment) at workplaces of dormitory, damage, remove or decommission the equipment or any part thereof
- 4) The resident is informed** that the buildings are equipped with an electric fire alarm system (EPS) and related devices. In the event of an alarm, the resident must immediately evacuate.
