

## **Rules for accommodation in connection with the epidemiological situation (COVID-19)**

### **I.**

In accordance with the Operating Rules of Accommodation Services TUO\_LEG\_10\_003 as amended and in accordance with the valid legislation, this notification is issued, which regulates the rules for accommodation in VŠB-TUO accommodation services facilities in connection with the epidemiological situation (COVID-19).

### **II.**

1. All those interested in accommodation must sign the Statutory declaration in connection with the epidemiological situation (COVID-19) (see Annexe 1).
2. The rules for accommodation of foreign nationals are governed by the issued rules for entry into the territory of the Czech Republic (CR) according to the protective measure of the Ministry of Health of the Czech Republic (MH CR) as amended. The rules are available on the website of the Ministry of the Interior of the Czech Republic <https://www.mvcr.cz/imgDetail.aspx?docid=22259870>.
2. 1. Accommodation of citizens from countries for which a COVID-19 Test (hereinafter "PCR Test") is required upon entry into the Czech Republic on the basis of a protective measure of the Ministry of Health of the Czech Republic is governed by the following instructions:
  - If the citizen has a valid negative PCR Test passed in the Czech Republic at COVID 19, accommodation will be provided without further restrictions.
  - If the citizen has a valid negative PCR Test passed outside the Czech Republic at COVID 19, the accommodation services require the PCR test made in the Czech Republic, the result of which the citizen must submit to Accommodation Services staff within 72 hours of entering the Czech Republic.
  - In the event that the citizen does not have any test, he must pass the PCR test within 72 hours of entering the territory of the Czech Republic and submit it to the staff of Accommodation Services.
  - Citizens who do not have a valid negative PCR test passed in the Czech Republic will be accommodated in the reserved areas of the VŠB-TUO dormitories for a maximum of 5 days.
  - Until the submission of a valid PCR test, the ban on free movement within the territory of the Czech Republic and the obligation to wear respiratory protective equipment (masks) apply. Prohibition of free movement means restrictions on movement, with the exception to procure basic necessities: medical examination, school and employment, until the result of the PCR Test is presented to Accommodation Services staff.

## STATUTORY DECLARATION

I declare that:

- I have not suffered in the last three weeks and have not suffered from a deterioration in health in the sense of cough, difficulty breathing or fever, feelings of general weakness or pain in muscle groups or more joints on the day of signing this statutory declaration,
- I have not stayed more than 12 hours in the last 14 days in a country that is not on the current list of countries with a low risk of COVID-19.

I further declare that the information in this statutory declaration is true and I have not intentionally withheld any information I know and that I am aware that by providing false information in this statutory declaration I may seriously endanger the health or even the lives of other persons moving indoors. VŠB-TUO. I am further aware that by knowingly providing false information, I am exposed to the risk of criminal prosecution for the spread of contagious human disease according to §152 and §153 of Act. No. 40/2009 Coll., Criminal Code.
